

Condition Scoring key:

If any condition listed below is not assessed please write N/C= not checked

Conditions in this column should be checked at least once each day by an RVT or member of the medical team, and the results recorded in the appropriate box on the front of this sheet.

Conditions in this column should be checked frequently during each day and the results recorded in the appropriate box on the front of this sheet. All staff caring for these animals should be encouraged to record their observations of any of the following.

MOUTH:

- 0= No oral involvement
- 1= Moderate to marked stomatitis
- 2= Less than one oral ulcer <3mm in diameter
- 3= Multiple or one >3 mm oral ulcer

EYE:

- 0= No ocular involvement
- 1= Serous (clear) ocular discharge, squinting and/or mild conjunctivitis
- 2= Mucopurulent (green or yellow) or bloody discharge and/or moderate to marked conjunctivitis
- 3= Corneal ulcers

URI:

- 0= No nasal discharge, sneezing (ocular signs only)
- 1= Serous (clear) nasal discharge and/or sneezing
- 2= Mucopurulent (green or yellow, bloody) nasal discharge or sneezing
- 3= Systemic disease (fever, anorexia, marked depression, dehydration)

HYDRATION:

- 0= Adequately hydrated
- 5= Slightly dehydrated (Mildly tacky gums, slow return of tented skin)
- 8= Severely dehydrated (Dry gums, sunken eyes, slow return of tented skin to normal state).

ATTITUDE:

- BAR= Bright, Alert, Responsive
- QAR= Quiet, Alert, Responsive
- ↓ = Dull

↓↓ = Markedly unresponsive

FECES:

- = No feces seen in cage
- + = Yes, if Animal has defecated please characterize as *N normal, L loose, D diarrhea, or B blood i.e. BD,BL*

URINE:

- =No urine observed in cage
- + =Yes, please characterize only if urine appears abnormal.

APPETITE & H₂O CONSUMPTION (water) :

- = Not Eating/drinking
- + = Eating/Drinking
